IDP-1 ~ INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT PLANS

Thank you to you all who attended our first IDP conferences, to hear about how well your tamariki have been doing so far this year. We had a 76% turnout. Our kaiako / teachers will be in touch with those parents who couldn't make it, to make another time, or at least chat over the phone. These are important hui where your tamariki tell you about their learning and their goals for the rest of the year.

ASSESSMENTS & IDP-1

We have now completed our Maths and Writing assessments. These results will be used to give your child an overall teacher judgement on how well they are doing in Maths and Writing - in your child's IDP-1 report, you will see their Maths and Writing results, as well as their Reading results. We had 77% of parents and whānau come to our IDP hui. If you weren't able to make it, your child's teacher will be in touch soon.

COOK ISLANDS '24

We have had our second information hui. 67 adults and children have said they are interested in coming. At our second meeting, we decided that each person would need to pay a deposit of \$250 by 1 June. We also agreed that as a group, we would commit to raising half the amount that the group needed. Whānau would need to raise the other \$1000. This will give a clear indication of your commitment. This is such a wonderful and exciting opportunity and we look forward to taking as many young people on the trip as we can. From Term 2, '100%ers' will also go into a draw for 4x\$50 gift cards to be awarded to whanau at mid-Term and the end of Term 2.
